



## BIO of JAN MATTSSON 麦守信博士 简介

For three decades, until 2014, Jan Mattsson made a career within the United Nations, advancing to the level of Under-Secretary-General, reporting directly to Secretary-Generals Kofi Anan and Ban Ki-Moon. From 2014-2019, he served as Inspector, reporting to the Board of the World Bank Group on compliance with social and environmental safeguards of investments.

Jan Mattsson is Chief Strategic Advisor to the Global Steering Committee for Carbon Neutral Action (GSCCNA). He is concurrently Board Chairman of two social enterprises. Everimpact, registered in France, is based on an innovative technology to measure and reduce greenhouse gas emissions in cities and selected industries. SolarSack, registered in Denmark, is using solar radiation to provide safe and affordable drinking water to poor people in the developing world. He is also Chairman of the Museum of United Nations – UN Live, a cultural institution working globally to stimulate local action towards the Sustainable Development Goals. Additionally, Jan Mattsson is advisor to the Executive Director of the Green Climate Fund, headquartered in the Republic of Korea.

Jan Mattsson is a Swedish national. He has a Ph. D. in Engineering, with a focus on management of technological change.

在过去的30年里，Jan Mattsson 博士在联合国长期担任高级领导职务，曾任联合国副秘书长兼联合国项目事务署执行主任，直接向科菲·安南秘书长和潘基文秘书长汇报工作。2014-2019年，他任职世界银行检查官委员会核心成员，向世界银行集团董事会报告投资的社会和环境保障措施的合规情况。

Jan Mattsson 博士亦是全球碳中和行动指导委员会（GSCCNA）的首席战略顾问，同时还在两家关注可持续发展领域与气候变化机构担任主席，包括 Everimpact 是一家基于一项创新技术来测量和减少城市 and 特定行业的温室气体排放的社会企业，SolarSack 是利用太阳辐射为发展中国家的贫困人口提供安全和实惠的饮用水的社会型企业。

Jan Mattsson 博士也是联合国博物馆-联合国 Live 的主席，这是一个在全球范围内致力于激励地方行动以实现可持续发展目标的文化机构。此外，Jan Mattsson 先生还在总部设在韩国的绿色气候基金担任执行主任顾问。

Jan Mattsson 博士是瑞典人。他拥有工程学博士学位，主要研究技术变革与管理。
